



## CLEAN HANDS ON THE GO - WITH YOUR NEW SHOULDERSINK

With ShoulderSink, you'll be one of the few professionals on the go who has access to a REAL handwash on the go.

ShoulderSink is the alternative, or supplement, for wipes and industrial wipes, so you can have clean hands without having to go around with traces of chemicals and perfume on your hands during the day.

Water and soap (or hand cleanser) is the best way to clean dirty hands before using other products such as handrub. Both the CDC and WHO recommend using soap and water before handrubs when you have visibly dirty hands.



## LOCATION/INSTALLATION OF SHOULDERSINK

If you purchased an installation bracket for ShoulderSink, follow the instructions provided. Make sure to place the ShoulderSink in such a way so it cannot tip over during use or while driving. You should also be aware that ShoulderSink must be secured so that, in case of an accident, it cannot be thrown forward in the car.



With regards to where you place ShoulderSink, be sure to think through your daily use of the hose:



Do you take ShoulderSink out of the car before use?



Or should the hose be directly tilted down out of the door or the car boot and used?

## CONSUMPTION PRODUCTS ESPECIALLY ADAPTED TO YOUR SHOULDERSINK

Our products offer you an effective way to wash hands, while water consumption is at a minimum.

### Note

- ShoulderSink's hose is a consumer part, which over months and years of frequent use can become a bit loose. You can reorder replacement hoses at [www.shouldersink.com](http://www.shouldersink.com) if necessary.
- ShoulderSink must stand upright because if it topples over, and there is pressure on the tank, a few drops of water may leak.
- ShoulderSink should not be left outside for long periods in freezing weather.

# SHOULDERSINK & THE ENVIRONMENT

As a user (and/or company) you are responsible for all waste water you let out in to our environment. Both through installation, sewer and directly in the nature.

We have developed our soaps according to European standards, from fast biodegradable components. However, to spare the environment from any pollution this is how we suggest using the ShoulderSink when washing your hands;

- Lower the hose with your arm.
  - Wet your hands.
  - Close the hose again with your arm
- >
- Use one pump of the product.
  - Scrub thoroughly
- >
- Wipe the soap or hand cleaner off in a small piece of paper
  - Put the paper in the bin.
- >
- Lower the hose with your arm
  - Rinse your hands with water.
  - Close the hose again with your arm
- >
- Dry your hands with a short piece of paper (20-25 cm).
  - Put the paper in the bin

No matter if you use ShoulderSink Soap or other "outdoor" soap products;



- Never release water with soap in the vicinity of surface water (lakes, streams, rivers, sea)
- For any soap to be biological degraded, it needs time in the soil to be consumed by bacteria.

If you have Dangerous chemicals or materials on your hands before washing, make sure to either follow our recommended process, or make sure to use a bucket to catch the dirty water from the handwash.

**If you use our recommended process, You are doing the environment a huge favor;**

- No soap are released in to the environment
- Water consumption is 90% less compared to using a regular sink

## QUICK GUIDE

### Valve & lid for the water tank.

Open the valve when using Shouldersink. Close after use.

### Water

Remove the plug before use. Use your wrist to raise and lower the hose so that it does not get dirty.

### Pumps with Soap, Hand Cleanser or Alcohol.

The products can be reordered from your supplier.

### Paper

Pull up and forward and tear the paper off.
